Instructions & how to avoid being charged extra \$\$\$:

Thank you for renting my car — I'm a real person, not some big company, that makes it available for others, so please treat it as you would your own! Here are tips that will make things easy and help avoid any added costs:

- This car uses on-street parking. The Getaround app will show you an permitted radius to park in within I/4th mile centered at 2120 13th Street NW but due to a series of break-ins, I strongly, strongly ask you to not park within two blocks of the dead center of the radius and try to park on my recommended streets. Please refer to the reverse of this guide for more information. Be 100% sure the spot is legal for 24 hours beyond the time your rental ends. Do NOT park at a meter, 2 hour parking, any rush hour lane etc. FYI: street sweeping restrictions are not in effect from October 31 to March 1. During your rental itself, the car is legal to street park anywhere in Zone 1 for as long as you want, or anywhere else in the city for up to 2 hours. See the fip side of this page for tons more detailed parking help.
- **Absolutely no smoking at any time** in the vehicle no exceptions, no matter what, do not smoke or vape ANYTHING in this car! The car is inspected between each rental for any damage, fuel level and evidence of smoking. There is a \$500 cleaning fee for ANY smoking in the car. Getaround is serious about enforcing the no-smoking rule don't find out the hard way with a \$500 charge!
- Before beginning your rental, be sure to walk around the car and note any significant damage in the Getaround app to timestamp any damage as being present before your rental started.
- Getaround users are responsible for refilling the gas they use, <u>EVEN FOR SHORT TRIPS!</u> Be sure to fill the tank to avoid charges! Check the fuel level before you start the rental: if it's not full, you are only responsible for returning it at the level you picked it up. If you don't replace the gas used even for a very short trip! it's automatically charged to you via Getaround at a very high rate per gallon ...you really want to avoid this!
- Please leave the car as clean as you found it. At the conclusion of your rental, please tidy up and remove all trash. Getaround imposes a cleaning fee of \$100 for any excessive dirt/trash/stains.
 Absolutely no pets in the car at any time!
- Please return the key to the lockbox after your rental and make sure to fully hide the lockbox & this sheet under the passenger seat. The combination for the lockbox can be found in the pickup instructions for your rental in the app.
- EZPass tolls are automatically charged to you via Getaround, so feel free to use any EZPass lane during your rental there is no physical EZPass tag within the vehicle, it's charged via the license plate number.

For issues specific to the Getaround system, billing, your reservation, or if you have a major problem like an accident, call Getaround at 415-549-9332

Almost all problems can be handled by Getaround very quickly. Getaround Parking Guide

The "acceptable parking radius" is 1/4 mile around 2120 13th St NW. Due to break ins by people using the app to find cars, **do not park** on the streets in the dead center of the radius marked in red on the map — please try to park on the two "green" preferred streets listed below, or around the "edges" of the radius. Parking one to two blocks outside of the radius is OK, too.

The preferred parking is on Wallach Place NW between 13th and 14th NW or T Street NW between 11th and 14th — highlighted in GREEN below. There are often tons of safe spots on those block — please, please try those first

Do not park in any metered spot (so avoid U Street and 14th Street altogether)

Do not park in a "2 hour only" spot (W St between 13th/14th has a lot of these especially...avoid!)

Do not park in a rush hour spot, at a fire hydrant, or commercial loading zones.

Make sure the spot is 100% legal for at least 24 hours after you park — but street cleaning is not in effect until March 1st, so you can ignore those signs during the winter.

The car has a zone one street parking permit and the entire radius is in zone one.
